1) THE RING

A. All Posts and ropes to be well padded and a safe distance from walls or pillars. Floor to be padded with felt, rubber, or other suitable, approved material as per CABA rule 1. ©.

B. If the ring is raised (CABA rule 1, A to E).

2) GLOVES & HEADGEAR FOR SPARRING

Only approved CABA sparring and/or competitive gloves and head guards shall be used, in good condition

- no tears or breaks

- no laces

- thumb attached

- padding in good condition

- 14oz - 16oz for sparring

- 10 oz. for competition

3) TRAINING & FITNESS EQUIPMENT

- a) All equipment should be checked for safety and maintenance requirements on a regular basis (daily/weekly).
- b) Heavy bags, speed bags, double-end bags, etc. shall be secured in that they will pose no danger to boxers or coaches (check for wear/looseness of nuts-bolts, chains, bungee cords, etc.).
