

Match Guidelines for Boxing Ontario Club Shows & Tournaments as per Boxing Canada 2025

CLASSIFICATIONS:

U13 (11/12 yrs) = old Jr A U15 (13/14 yrs) = old Jr B U17 (15/16 yrs) = old Jr C U19 (17/18 yrs) = old Youth

AGE ALLOWANCES as per Year of Birth

- Fun Box (6-10 yrs is mandatory **U13 CAN also participate**) 12-month age difference allowed
- U13 vs U13 12-month max age difference allowed U13 not allowed to "compete up" in U15
- U13 vs U15 24-month age difference allowed
- U15 vs U15 12-month max age difference allowed U15 not allowed to "compete up" in U17
- U15 vs U17 24-month age difference allowed
- U17 vs U17 12-month max age difference allowed U17 not allowed to "compete up" in U19
- U17 vs U19 upon approval of Supervisor only
- U19 vs U19 12-month max age difference allowed
- U19 who is in their 18th year of birth & open may "compete up in Elite if they have a minimum of 10 bouts
- Master's 40 years of age or over may only box opponent up to 10 years older/younger by DOB

DEVELOPMENTAL (Dev) BOUTS (Exhibitions)

- Boxers are matched on age, weight and experience as described in the rules
- No decision both hands raised (unless stoppage) passbook entry "Dev Bout"

WEIGHT ALLOWANCES **When not in the same Weight Class**

Male – Elite and U19

Under 90 kg
5 kg difference allowed

Over 90 kg
No maximum weight difference

<u>Female – Elite and U19</u>

Under 60 kg
60 kg to 80 kg
3 kg difference allowed
5 kg difference allowed

Over 80 kg
No maximum weight difference

Male & Female – U17 / U15 / U13

Under 54 kg
54 kg - 66 kg
66kg - 80 kg
3 kg difference allowed
5 kg difference allowed

Over 80 kg
No maximum weight difference

Male and Female Funbox

All weight classes
3 kg difference allowed

Male and Female Master's

All weight classes
5 kg difference allowed

CATEGORY OF BOXER

- Novice 10 bouts or fewer
- Open more than 10 bouts or has been upgraded

HEADGEAR

- Open face headgear is mandatory for all HOWEVER
- Funbox & Master's may wear headgear with cheek protector as long as both wear the same type

EXPERIENCE ALLOWANCES

Maximum 10 bout difference Funbox bouts Maximum 7 bout difference Novice vs Novice Novice vs Open Maximum 5 bout difference

Open vs Open No limit, each competitor's experience considered

GLOVES

- 12 oz gloves Elite & U19 Male above 65 kg
- 16 oz gloves Master's AND Developmental boxers >65kg
- 10 oz gloves all other bouts (Females, U17, U15, U13, Elite & U19 under 65kg, Dev 28kg-65kg, FunBox)

8 COUNTS

Open – all 3 in a round, maximum 4 in a bout • Novice – all 2 in a round, maximum 3 in a bout • Developmental – all 1 in a round, up to 2 in a bout

Funbox – all 1 in the bout

ROUNDS

•	Elite and U19 Open	3 x 3
•	Elite and U19 Novice	3 x 2
•	U17 (Open and Novice)	3 x 2
•	U15 (Open and Novice)	3 x 1.5
•	U13 (Open and Novice)	3 x 1
•	Funbox	3 x 1

Master's

0	41 – 45 years	3 x2
0	46 – 55 years	3 x 1.5
0	56 years and over	3 x 1

NOTE

- Boxers may box less than allowed rounds but not more
- For all boxers except Master's the length of rounds is determined by the lowest age classification of boxers in the match
- Master's length of rounds is determined by the highest age classification of the boxers
