

COVID-19 SOCIAL CIRCLE RECOMMENDATIONS

July 19, 2020

In order for a member organization to implement "SOCIAL CIRCLES" the following must be considered and/or occur.

- 1. A "SOCIAL CIRCLE" is a term used by the Government of Ontario to allow groups of people to interact without physical or social distancing rules.
- 2. Please realize that utilizing a social circle does not eliminate the risk of COVID-19 transmission and could be considered a riskier activity.
- 3. A social circle plan must be developed and agreed upon by all persons involved (as per the Government of Ontario information).
- 4. If one (1) member of the social circle becomes ill or test positive for COVID-19 all members should isolate and seek testing. In addition, communication with the local public health is recommended.
- 5. All members of a "SOCIAL CIRCLE" should fill out the Boxing Ontario "Social Circle agreement" or a similar agreement (as per the Government of Ontario Information).
- 6. At no time shall the total size of a social circle exceed the number allowed by government or public health regulations.

- 8. It is recommended that the local Public Health be contacted to ensure this meets their requirements.
- 9. An example of a working social circle (of 7 people) is as follows:
 - Athlete A
 - i. Athlete A's life partner; who the athlete lives with.
 - Athlete B
 - i. Athlete B's mother; who the athlete lives with.
 - ii. Athlete B's father; who the athlete lives with.
 - iii. Athlete B's sister; who the athlete lives with
 - iv. Athlete B's partner; who the athlete has close contact with.
